* **“DEFINITELY NOT FOR DUMMIES: THE BASICS OF CHRISTIANITY”** - Led by Stephen Farris. I will be offering a five week study of the Basics of the Christian Faith here at St. Mark's Church, beginning in the New Year. It will take place **after church beginning at 12:00 noon and last for one hour. Feel free to bring a brown bag lunch to church for these studies. The dates of the meetings are: January 14, 21, 28 and February 11 and 18.** The studies will have two purposes. The first is as a preparation for making or renewing a profession of faith and becoming a member of the congregation. There are also many who simply feel they need a refresher course in the basics of the faith. This set of studies can fulfill that purpose also.
